

CRITERIA

The Carroll County Medical Society Scholarship Fund

PURPOSE:

The Carroll County Medical Society Scholarship Fund is to honor a different member of the Carroll County Medical Society each year by awarding a one-time scholarship to a resident of Carroll County, graduating from college, who has been accepted into any onshore medical school.

SCHOLARSHIP SELECTION CRITERIA

- A. Scholarship(s) will be awarded each year to the student(s) who meets the following criteria:
- The Student shall be a resident of Carroll County;
 - The Student shall be a College Senior, accepted into any onshore medical school;
 - The applicant shall attach to the application a 500 word or less essay on his/her goals;
 - The Student shall complete the application and provide all requested information.
- B. The administration of the scholarship shall be as follows:
- The recipient may apply directly to the Community Foundation of Carroll County, Inc.
 - The Community Foundation of Carroll County will forward all applications to the Carroll County Medical Society Scholarship Committee for review.
 - The Carroll County Medical Society Scholarship Committee will provide the Community Foundation of Carroll County with the nominated student's name. The Board of Directors of the Community Foundation of Carroll County must approve the choice of the Scholarship Committee.
 - The award will be presented at the component meeting of the Carroll County Medical Society and information and photo will be published in the local newspaper.

- All income generated from the Scholarship Fund shall be used for the purpose above described.
- The amount and number of the awards may vary based upon the financial status of Carroll County Medical Society and income earnings of the Fund.
- The money shall be transmitted by the Community Foundation of Carroll County directly to medical school the recipient will attend and applied directly to the student's fees. The monies shall not be remitted to the scholarship winner(s) directly.
- The Community Foundation of Carroll County in conjunction with the Carroll County Medical Society will determine the application process.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE SCHOLARSHIP FUND

The Community Foundation will transmit checks made payable to the medical school where the recipient will be attending on or about July of each year. The transfer will be in accordance with applicable regulations and laws governing such funds.

- A. The scholarship winner(s) will be selected in accordance with the selection criteria identified in this document and the Scholarship Fund Agreement.
- B. The Community Foundation of Carroll County shall administer the program in a prudent financial manner.
- C. The Community Foundation of Carroll County shall submit an annual financial report to the Carroll County Medical Society.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF BOARD

- A. The successful scholarship recipients will be selected in accordance with the selection criteria identified in the Agreement.
- B. The Community Foundation of Carroll County shall administer the program in a prudent financial manner and the funds may be

commingled with other funds of the Community Foundation of Carroll County.
