

CRITERIA

THE JON BRUCE SCHOLARSHIPS

PURPOSE: The purpose of the JON BRUCE SCHOLARSHIPS is to honor his memory by providing scholarships for graduating seniors at Liberty High School in Carroll County Maryland and Dulaney High School in Baltimore County Maryland.

The JON BRUCE SCHOLARSHIP will be awarded to a student graduating from Liberty High School with the same character and dedication to baseball embodied by Jon himself and they will be pursuing an undergraduate degree at an accredit college or university. Teachers and coaches will nominate deserving, senior baseball players on their attitude, camaraderie, friendship and sportsmanship. In fact it will be this character that will be recognized not athletic or academic achievements. In addition the nominee must have played baseball for two years on the LHS team and have shown compassion and respect towards others, built and maintained positive rapport with those around them and exemplified dedication on and off the field.

FUND SELECTION CRITERIA:

- A. FUNDS will be awarded to a Nominee who meets the following criteria:
1. The student will be a member of the Liberty High School graduation class and have played on the LHS Baseball team for two years.
 2. The student will have been accepted at an accredited college or university.
 3. The student will have demonstrated those personal characteristics as listed above.
 4. All applicants are required to write a 500 word essay on one of three topics. 1. How cancer has effected them. 2. A challenge they have overcome. 3. How they have helped someone in need.
- B. The administration of the FUND shall be as follows:

1. The recipient(s) shall be nominated by a teacher or Coach at Liberty High School, and approved by the Board of Directors of the Community Foundation of Carroll County. Donors reserve the right to make the award presentation.
2. All income in the Fund shall be used for fund purposes.
3. The money shall be transmitted by the Community Foundation of Carroll County directly to the desired college or university and applied directly to the student's tuition and books. The monies shall not be remitted to the FUND winner.

THE MR. BRUCE CHARACTER AWARD The recipient of this award will be a college bound student intending to pursue a career in special education and possessing the same dedication to helping students with special needs as Mr. Bruce. Additionally, the recipient will be an individual of character, someone who consistently shows compassion and respect toward others, maintains positive rapport with those around him/her and exemplifies school spirit.

FUND SELECTION CRITERIA

A. Funds will be awarded to nominees who meet the following criteria:

1. The nominee will be a graduating student at Dulaney High School in Baltimore County, Maryland.
2. The nominee will have been accepted at an accredited college or university.
3. The nominee will have expressed the intention to pursue a career in Special Education.
4. All applicants are required to write a 500 word essay on one of three topics. 1. How cancer has effected them. 2. A challenge they have overcome. 3. How they have helped someone in need.

The administration of the Mr. Bruce character Award will be as follows:

1. The student will be nominated by a special education faculty member at Dulaney High School in Baltimore County, Maryland and approved by the Board of Directors of the Community Foundation of Carroll County, Inc. Donor reserves the right to make the presentation.
2. All income from the fund will be used for scholarship purposes.
3. The money shall be transmitted directly to the desired college or university and applied directly to the students credit. No money will be given directly to the student.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

RESPONSIBILITIES OF FUNDS

The Community Foundation will transmit a check made payable to the institutions of higher learning chosen on or about August 1 of each year. The transfers will be in accordance with applicable regulations and laws governing such funds.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF BOARD

- A. The successful student recipients will be selected in accordance with the selection criteria identified in the Agreement.
- B. The Community Foundation of Carroll County shall administer the program in a prudent financial manner and the funds may be commingled with other funds of the Community Foundation of Carroll County.
