

CRITERIA

THE MANUFACTURING AND MACHINE TECHNOLOGY SCHOLARSHIP

The purpose of the MANUFACTURING AND MACHINE TECHNOLOGY SCHOLARSHIP Is to provide a scholarship for a graduating senior at The Carroll County Career and Technology Center in Westminster Maryland perusing a career in Manufacturing and Machining Technology

The MANUFACTURING AND MACHINE TECHNOLOGY SCHOLARSHIP will be awarded To a graduating or continuing student from the Carroll County Career and Technology Center pursuing an undergraduate degree or certificate at an accredited technical school, college or university, who meets the criteria established for the fund.

Grants may also be made to students for the purchase of tools

FUND SELECTION CRITERIA:

- A. FUNDS will be awarded to an applicant who meets the following criteria:
1. The student will be a member of the Carroll County Career and Technology Center graduating class or a continuing student from that school.
 2. The student will have been accepted at an accredited technical school, college or university.
 3. The student will have maintained a GPA of 3.0 for his or her high school career and have college worthy SAT scores.
 4. The student will have a demonstrated interest in pursuing a career in Manufacturing or Machine Technology
- B. The administration of the FUND shall be as follows:
1. The recipient(s) shall be selected by the Donor or their designee, and approved by the Board of Directors of the Community Foundation of Carroll County. Donor reserves the right to make the award presentation.

2. All income in the Fund shall be used for fund purposes.
3. The money shall be transmitted by the Community Foundation of Carroll County directly to the desired technical school, college or university and applied directly to the student's tuition and books. The monies shall not be remitted to the FUND winner except in the case of an award for tools. In that case the student may present an invoice for payment or partial payment or reimbursement. .

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

RESPONSIBILITIES OF FUND

The Community Foundation will transmit a check made payable to the institutions of higher learning chosen on or about July 1 of each year. The transfers will be in accordance with applicable regulations and laws governing such funds.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF BOARD

- A. The successful student recipients will be selected in accordance with the selection criteria identified in the Agreement.
- B. The Community Foundation of Carroll County shall administer the program in a prudent financial manner and the funds may be commingled with other funds of the Community Foundation of Carroll County.
