

CRITERIA

The Walter J. Hackett, Sr. and Anna E. Hackett Memorial Scholarship Fund

The Walter J. Hackett, Sr. and Anna E. Hackett Memorial Fund Scholarship Fund was established by their son, Walter J. Hackett, Jr., in their memory as a tribute to their dedication to and appreciation of the benefits of a Catholic School Education. Neither Walter J. Hackett, Sr. nor Anna E. Hackett was a highly educated person, but each made many sacrifices to be sure that their three children had elementary and secondary Catholic School Education. Mr. and Mrs. Hackett, Sr. were both members of the St. John Roman Catholic Community Parish. Mr. Hackett died in 1981 followed in death by his wife in 1995.

PURPOSE:

The purpose of the Fund is to provide scholarships for students demonstrating a need for financial assistance who wish to attend St John's School, the elementary school run by Saint John Roman Catholic Community in Westminster, Maryland.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

RESPONSIBILITIES OF MEMORIAL FUND

The Community Foundation will transmit checks made payable to St John's School, on or about July 1st of each year. The transfer will be in accordance with applicable regulations and laws governing such trusts.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF BOARD

- A. The chosen recipient(s) will be selected in accordance with the selection criteria identified in this document and the Memorial Fund Agreement.
- B. The Community Foundation of Carroll County shall administer the program in a prudent financial manner.
- C. The Community Foundation of Carroll County shall submit an annual financial report to the Donor and/or his designee.

SCHOLARSHIP SELECTION CRITERIA

A scholarship will be awarded each year to a student who meets the following criteria:

- The student shall be a member of St John Roman Catholic Community Parish.
- The scholarship will be awarded on the basis of financial need.
- Once a student has been awarded a Scholarship, he or she must apply again for subsequent years. Students applying for Scholarships after the first year will be evaluated against the following additional criteria:
 - a) Academic Excellence
 - b) Extra Curricular Participation
 - c) Exemplary Character:
Student must demonstrate real concern for others as evidenced through service learning, contributions to school and/or the community-at-large. Must be respected by both peers and staff.

The administration of the scholarship shall be as follows:

- The recipient shall be selected by the Scholarship Committee of St John's School and approved by the Board of Directors of the Community Foundation of Carroll County.
- The Scholarship Committee of St John's School will provide the Community Foundation of Carroll County with the nominated student's name.
- All income generated from the Scholarship Fund shall be used for the scholarship award.
- The amount and number of the awards may vary based upon the earnings of the Fund
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- The money shall be transmitted by the Community Foundation of Carroll County directly to St John's School and applied directly to the student's tuition and books. The monies shall not be remitted to the scholarship winner directly. If a student does not enter school or having entered, drops out, the scholarship grant or part thereof refunded shall revert to The Walter J. Hackett, Sr. and Anna E. Hackett Memorial Fund.
- The application process will be determined by the Community Foundation of Carroll County in conjunction with the Scholarship Committee of St John's School.
